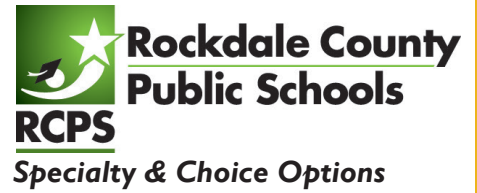

Program Overview

General Ray Davis Middle School, in support of the Rockdale County Public Schools vision to offer expanded learning options, offers a rigorous fine arts program specifically targeting the performing and visual arts. The goal of the Academy for Performing and Visual Arts is to explore and develop artistic talents within young students by making the arts part of each student's core learning experience. The program offers:

- Discrete arts instruction in dance, theatre arts, vocals, band, strings, photography, video, and visual arts;
- Integration of arts across other content areas: math, science, language arts, and social studies.

Academy classes prepare students for the next level of performing and/or visual arts education while maintaining high academic achievement.



Application, Eligibility, and Artistic Review

RCPS will use an electronic application process for 2024-2025 School Choice programs. No paper applications will be accepted. Students may apply for **one** School Choice program only for the 2024-2025 school year.

The application window is November 10 through December 15, 2023, to apply for the 2024-2025 school year. The online application will be available on the district website at: rockdaleschools.org Only completed applications will be accepted for consideration.

Eligibility Criteria

- Students must meet standards in ELA, Reading, Math, Science, and Social Studies on the Milestones assessment.
- Students must meet the student registration requirement for Rockdale County Public Schools.*
- Students and parents must agree to the Choice contract.

*All students must reside in Rockdale County or have a parent employed with RCPS to apply. Students residing in Rockdale County but attending home or private school who are accepted must fully enroll in RCPS in June. RCPS policy JCB-R will apply to all RCPS employee children who are accepted.

Audition/Artistic Review

Please plan to attend the Parent Information Session at DMS on **Tuesday, October 17, 2023, 5 p.m. to 6 p.m.**, to learn about requirements for the Academy and the Audition/Artistic Review process.

Our school is named for a great hero and late resident of Rockdale County, Medal of Honor winner General Ray Davis. He earned this medal and many other recognitions for exemplary service to our country. He was one of 94 men — three Georgians — to earn the Medal of Honor in the Korean War. His awards include the Navy Cross, the nation's second highest decoration for bravery, two Silver Stars, and the Bronze Star with Combat "V" for valor. He became one of the most decorated veterans in U.S. History. We are proud to be named for such a great person!
